**5. Dig with care.**

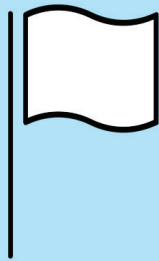




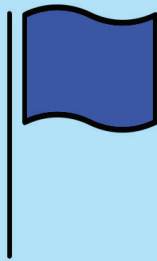


# Know the colors!

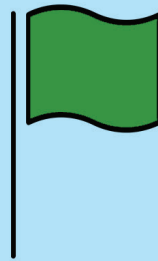
The nationally adopted Uniform Color Code is used to mark the approximate location of underground facilities. The markings appear as flags, paint, or both.



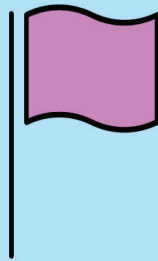

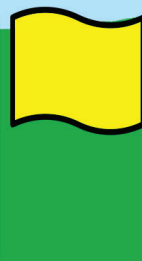

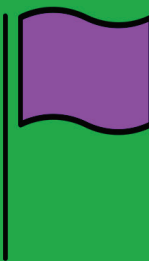
