MISS DIG 811 Certification



Under the mandate of Public Act 174, MISS DIG 811 is responsible for the education of stakeholders in the excavation community, including facility owner/operators, locators and excavators. The course explains, in detail, the MISS DIG 811 process and lays out damage prevention and safety practices. It covers requirements for underground facility owners as well as clarifying requirements for those excavators working near underground lines. It provides practical, up-to-date tools which help navigate the process and bring about the

most efficient, safe outcome possible. MISS DIG 811 Certification is currently good for 3 years and you can take the course online or attend a live workshop.

MISS DIG 811 Certification qualifies as the training portion of your company's safety management program, which is one of the requirements of becoming Gold Shovel Standard (GSS) Certified.
